From 24.-26. In April, the members of the European Working Group met in Brussels to work on further details for the new Food Safety in the Supply Chain guideline.

- 1. Subgroup:** Tank, Container, Bulk and IBC's. Hygienic Design, Global Identification, Food Contact Material, Traceability, Food Defense
- 2. Subgroup:** Loading and unloading in the process, digitization, training
- 3. Subgroup:** Cleaning Stations. Cleaning and disinfection, cleaning processes, cleaning certificates , certification of cleaning stations, training. Digitization, validation and verification

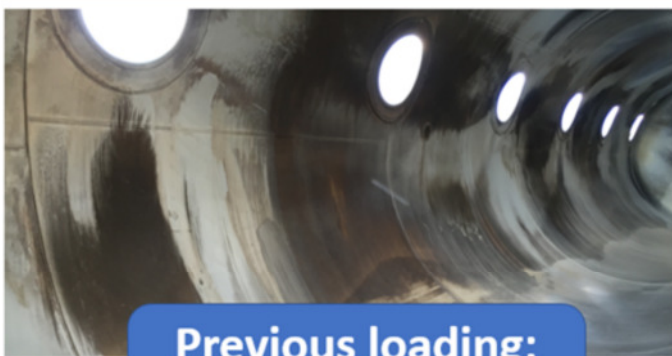

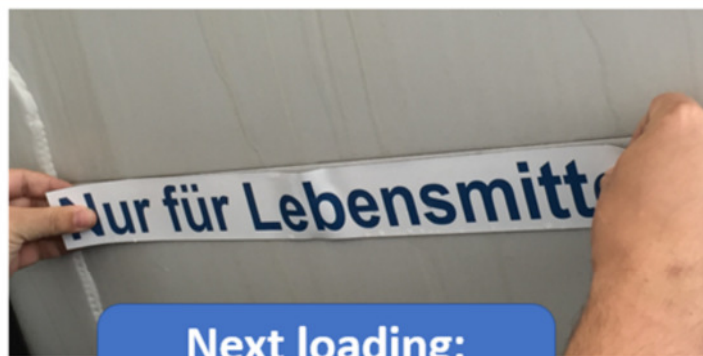

When asked what is the reason: The driver replied that he would not be loaded in the dairy where he will load milk powder without the "food stuff only" lable. According to EU Regulation 178- 2002, the transport of plastic particles in food containers is forbidden.
